**Shusuikan**  
(Event Hall, Exhibition Hall)  
Performances of Peking Opera and music played with Chinese instruments, exhibits of Chinese art.

**MultiTheater** (Cheuken)  
Learn about the background of Enchoen and gardens in China with videos.

**Mt. Heavenly Pond** (Tenchizan)  
At the summit of Stone Mountain there is said to be a small pond. The stones here came from the cliffs at the pass on Mt. Yan in Hebei Province.

**Flying Cloud Falls** (Hiunbaku)  
The water flows and falls, billowing into mist that is like flying clouds.

**Topmost Tower** (Ichirantei)  
Situated at the highest point of Enchoen, it commands a full view of entire park.

**Lotus Pond** (Hasu Pond)  
Seen in all its splendor from the Lotus Embraced Pavilion. The best time for viewing is from mid July to mid August.

**Seven Stars Bridge** (Nanahoshi Bridge)  
With its seven colors, the elegant lofted arch brings rainbows to mind.

**Water Gate** (Geisuibu)  
A grand gate to receive Imperial persons; a fitting wharf to greet and send off Imperial pleasure craft.



**Tea Terrace**  
Enjoy the true delight of Chinese tea.

**Encho Gate and Eiheki** (Enchomon)  
The main entrance and exit. Some of the splendor is due to the lapis lazuli roofing tiles, the deep blue hue of which was the imperial color.

**Cathay Hall** (Kaka Hall)  
In the Grand Pavilion at the center of Enchoen, there are numerous paintings. See, especially, animals in all their variety and the gold dragons that were the symbol of the emperor.

**Lotus Embraced Pavilion** (Shimenkafusha)  
Surrounded by the green leaves of lotus, it seems to drift on the surface of the water.

**Three Sights Villa** (Sankeiken)  
Take a seat on one of the stone benches and enjoy gazing through the windows at the Lotus Embraced Pavilion, Cathay Hall, and Topmost Tower.
